**Subject: Notification of Hearing and Decision**

**Re: Chile Player 91, GUTIERREZ Josefina, 2 yellow cards**

This is to inform you that a disciplinary hearing has been scheduled to address the 2 yellow cards that occurred during the Junior Pan American Championship, Women in Match # 8 and Match #10.

**Details of the Incident:** Two yellow cards issued during the following matches:

- Match #8 Chile vs Uruguay a yellow card was obtained for a 5-metre violation
- Match #10 Chile vs Mexico a yellow card was obtained for a 5-metre violation

**Hearing Details:** You are required to attend this hearing to discuss the incident and present any evidence or witnesses you may have and determine appropriate sanctions. Please be aware that failure to attend this hearing may result in a decision being made in your absence.

**Level of the Offense**

Code of Conduct Level 1

The two yellow cards were reviewed, which both were for 5-metre violations. Josefina Guterrez did acknowledge she understood the rule of the 5 metres and explained that she did not intentionally try to play the ball on both occasions.
